In this program, students will take courses in English writing, French, math (algebra, functions and trigonometry), physics, and chemistry. Students must achieve at least a 70% average in each of these courses in order to be considered for admission to the DEC in Health Sciences.

CONTINUING STUDIES/ CARRER PATHS

Students who are successful in the springboard program can go on to do a DEC health or pure and applied science.
