Bill 96 brings crucial changes to students pursuing Diplomas of Collegial Studies (DEC). The mandatory language requirements affect both students with Certification of Eligibility(COE) and those without.

Students with a Certificate of Eligibility (COE) must take and pass two complementary courses and one program-specific course in French. Students will need to pass the Ministerial English Exit Exam to graduate.

Students who don't have a Certificate of Eligibility(COE) must take and pass three French Language and Literature courses, one complementary course, and one program-specific course in French. Students without eligibility will now be required to pass the Ministerial French Exit Exam(Épreuve uniforme de français) to graduate.


* The course for program specific will vary depending on the programs.

Both Program Specific and Humanities is going to be done through our partnership College Decarie.
